Standard Room

ST. EUGENE GOLF COURSE

Ranked 3rd in *Golf Digest's* Best New Canadian Courses in 2001, the St. Eugene Golf Course more than matches the tradition of great golf in the BC Rockies. Designed by acclaimed architect Les Furber, it is indeed a masterpiece in an incredible setting. "This large property contained many different environments," says Furber, "allowing a freedom of style which is unusual in a single 18-hole layout."

The golf course moves through open links land, forests and spectacular view of the St. Mary River. To the east, the powerful image of Fisher Peak in the Rocky Mountains is a dominating feature, while on the opposite side of the valley the Purcell Mountains are etched against the sky. The 13th tee provides a panoramic view of this scene, but turns your attention to the task at hand, a stunning 220 yard par 3 with the green nestled 75 feet below!
